



### REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete IDR option #1, the language requirement

In addition, other course credits may count toward the concentration *with approval from the IB faculty member managing the concentration*. For example,

- A number of new courses with significant international content are periodically offered by the various areas in the school.
- KU has many Study Abroad partners and opportunities whose course work can count towards this concentration including the CIMBA program in Italy and the new UIBE program in China. *These courses require **prior** approval of the IB faculty member in charge of the concentration.* For those courses not offered by the KU School of Business, a course syllabus or detailed outline needs to be submitted as well as information about the instructor, the required readings/textbooks and the method of evaluation.
