



## KU MAcc Tuition & Fees Estimate

While the tuition and fees associated with the KU MAcc program may vary, the program is an affordable avenue for entering the accounting profession.

The tuition, fees and all calculations listed are for estimating purposes only. A student's actual tuition bill may vary based upon the number of classes taken, and prerequisite courses needed as well as the semester and the location of the class. The estimates below are based on the 2008-2009 academic year figures provided by the Kansas Board of Regents and are subject to change.
