Master of Accounting Degree Requirements

1. 30 hours to graduate
2. At least a 3.0 overall GPA to graduate
3. At least a C in each class (C- is not passing and the course will not count in the MAcc program)
4. No more than 6 hours of 500-level coursework
5. Must fulfill a track requirement to graduate
6. Classes may not double count in both undergraduate and MAcc degrees (ex. If take ACCT 545 as an undergraduate, still have a 30-hour MAcc program but can substitute another accounting elective for ACCT 545)
7. Credit/no credit is not allowed in graduate school
