



Dean's Certificate in International Business

The Dean's Certificate in International Business recognizes business students who have "gone the extra mile" to prepare themselves for a career in international business. Employers immediately recognize the value of the certificate, which requires an overseas experience, command of a foreign language, and advanced international elective courses. Many students who have completed the certificate now work for international businesses headquartered in the U.S. and abroad.

Certificate Requirements:

- Advanced foreign language study through Intermediate II (as defined by the relevant department), and the business language course where available (prerequisites may apply) Standardized foreign language proficiency test with a score of "High Intermediate" or above
- Two area studies courses (selected from the approved list of courses from Student Services) focusing on a single geographic area related to your language competency, and completed with a "B" or better in each course (these courses cannot be double counted with general education requirements)
- Three approved Advanced International Business Electives completed with a "B" or better in each course
- A study abroad experience or an international internship specifically approved for this certificate in the geographic area corresponding to the language and area study courses
