Kenneth Dam has devoted his career to public policy issues and world affairs. He served as deputy secretary (the second-ranking official) in both the U.S. Department of Treasury from 2001-2003 and in the U.S. State Department from 1982-1985.

Currently a professor of Law at the University of Chicago, Kenneth began his academic career at the University of Kansas School of Business, earning a Bachelor of Science in 1954. He has held a number of key roles in the federal government and business world, including serving as IBM vice president for law and external relations from 1985-1992.

Kenneth was awarded KU's Distinguished Service Citation in 1985 for extraordinary achievements in law and in the field of international relations.
