William R. (Bill) Docking is Chairman and CEO of Union State Bank, Arkansas City, Kansas and Chairman of City National Bank & Trust Company, Guymon, Oklahoma. He is also Chairman and President of Docking Bancshares, Inc., the holding company for both banks. He serves as Managing Member of Docking Development, L.L.C., an oil production company based in Oxford, Kansas, and as President of Cowley County Broadcasting, Inc., which owns two radio stations.

He was a member of the Kansas Board of Regents from 1995 through 2005 and served two terms as chair. He is a former President of the Kansas Bankers Association and a former Director of The University of Kansas Hospital Authority. Mr. Docking is currently a Director of the Kansas Health Foundation, a member of The University of Kansas Medical Center Advancement Board, a trustee of the Cowley County Community College Endowment Association and a member of the KU Endowment Association Executive Committee. He was a 2005 recipient of the Fred Ellsworth Medallion from the KU Alumni Association. He and his wife, Judy, are members of The KU Endowment Association's Mount Oread Society. In Arkansas City, he is Treasurer of the Community Health Foundation and is active in Rotary and the Chamber of Commerce. In 2006, he completed 20 years of service as an Advisory Director of the Cowley County Salvation Army.

William Docking has three degrees from The University of Kansas. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1973 and Master's of Business Administration and Juris Doctorate, both in 1977.
