Bill Grant is a business leader and public servant who graduated from the KU School of Business in 1939. As past chairman of Businessman's Assurance Co., a life and health insurance company, he believed that it should be the business of those who provide health insurance to improve health science.

As a member of the President's Council for the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, he developed the Life and Health Medical Research Fund to re-establish a foundation for biomedical research supported by the life and health insurance industry. At least five grantees have been awarded the Nobel Prize. He has been a director of Union Pacific Corp., Kansas City Power & Light Co. and Boatmen's First National Bank.

Bill serves on two boards in California where he resides—the Monterey Language Institute Board and Burnham Medical Research Board.
