Dub Hartley, a leading Kansas banker and philanthropist, served as board chairman of Miami County National Bank and president of the Kansas Bankers Association during his career. Nationally, he served as chairman of the Communications Council and on the Board of Directors of the Governing Council. As a former investment director for the Baehr Charitable Foundation Trust, Dub also helped provide assistance for programs that assist persons with disabilities.

Dub created the Hartley Family Hearing Center at the KU Medical Center and supported the KU Audio Reader Network. Dub graduated from the KU School of Business in 1946 and helped guide many programs as a member of the School's Board of Advisors. He died March 10, 2008 in Kansas City.
