H. Joseph Reitz graduated with honors from the KU School of Business in 1960. Joe served on the faculties of Indiana University, Georgia Institute of Technology, the University of Innsbruck (Austria), and the University of Florida, where he was named Teacher of the Year in 1976. He served as Associate Dean at Georgia Tech and was instrumental in founding their Center for Ethics and Values.

Joe joined the faculty of the KU School of Business in 1988 and, together with KU Professor of Philosophy Richard DeGeorge, founded the International Center for Ethics in Business in 1991.

He is the author of five books and numerous articles in management, ethics and human behavior in organizations. Joe served as faculty advisor for the Homeless Coalition, Justice for All, and KU Students for Life.

Joe has served as CEO of the Leo Center and Heartland Medical Clinic, a 501(c)3 organization dedicated to serving uninsured and underinsured people in the Lawrence community. He is now heading Family Promise, a faith-based program to serve homeless families and children.
