Frank Sabatini is chairman of the board and director, Capital City Bank, Topeka, and a senior member of Sabatini and Associates, Attorneys at Law. Frank also serves as the president and director of Kentucky Pizza Huts, a chain of restaurants in Kentucky and Ohio, and president of Mississippi Pizza Huts, which was sold to the National Pizza Company in 1988.
