

JOB CLUB

In response to the difficult employment landscape, the Business Career Services Center has launched a job club for students. Our hope is that this will provide an informative and supportive structure for students engaged in a job search and that participation will provoke actionable steps towards employment, either internship or full-time. During each meeting, the BCSC staff will provide basic structure and content around a career theme for each of the BCSC Job Club sessions, while group members will support one another through the employment process, offering tips, ideas, encouragement, contacts, and job leads to one another. Participants will receive a resource packet full of job search materials to supplement discussions each week.

The BCSC Job Club will be held during the Spring semester for 6 weeks and students are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to attend all 6 weeks. The exact dates and times will be promoted to students at the beginning of each Spring semester and below are the general topics covered during each meeting:

- Week 1: Self Assessment & Identifying Your Job Target
- Week 2: Resumes & Job Search Correspondence
- Week 3: Networking & Social Media
- Week 4: Job Search Basics & Interviewing
- Week 5: Overcoming Obstacles
- Week 6: Getting the Offer, Negotiating, and Transition Strategies
