

## **30 Hour Residency Requirement**

The 30-hour residency requirement requires students to take 30 hours of business credits after being admitted to the School. Several years ago the restricted enrollment requirement on the core 310 level courses was removed to allow students to begin taking core courses in a timely fashion. Because students now take some of the core courses before being admitted, some students who otherwise satisfy all degree requirements and take all of their courses at KU, may fail to satisfy the residency requirement. The Team agreed unanimously that the 310 core courses should count toward the 30-hour residency requirement even if they are taken prior to admission to the School. When a student is short total hours for the residency requirement, they must petition to the UG Appeals Committee to have any 310 courses taken at KU be included in their residency hours.
